Questions to Ask Your Healthcare Provider



As someone who has heart disease (or a family member with one), you are probably seeing a healthcare provider on a regular basis. Your healthcare provider is your partner in developing a proactive plan to maintain your long-term health. During your next appointment, use these questions to start a conversation about the possibility of a genetic cause for your heart disease and if genetic testing would be right for you.

QUESTIONS ABOUT HEART DISEASE

2.	Should I see a genetic counselor and/or consider genetic testing? Is there a genetic counselor you would recommend?
3.	Could genetic test results impact my treatment plan?
4.	What impact could genetic testing have on my family?
